

## 6<sup>th</sup> January 2019 - The Epiphany of the Lord

### From the Desk of the Pastor ....

The Gospel tell us that the wise men came searching for Christ. When they found Him, they worshipped Him, they opened their treasures and offered Him gifts of Gold, frankincense and myrrh. Then, having worshipped him, 'they returned to their own country by another route.'

Many have pondered on how this mystical encounter with the Divine child could have changed the course and direction of their lives.....

The human face of a tender loving God in Jesus must have transformed them... Prior to this encounter, the Magi needed the guiding light of a star to show them the way to Bethlehem; now the light of Christ itself that shone so bright that it illuminated their own hearts and minds. It was now their turn to go about spreading the good news of God's transforming love for them and for all nations in the world.

His light is 'the true light which enlightens all peoples'.
