FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Only St. Luke reports to us of the Seventy two disciples Jesus sent out. Apparently, there was too much to do for the Twelve Apostles. Even after choosing the seventy two, Jesus appears to be saying "there aren't enough of you." 'The harvest is great, but the laborers are few; pray for more workers for the harvest.'

This is an optimistic and yet a realistic statement. <<< What a lot of good there is that could be done in the world >>> The harvest is indeed rich, for those who have eyes to see it. But, when the chips are down, how few are willing to put themselves out to do it. Often we give in to the temptation of making excuses: 'I have no time, I have so much to do' etc., etc.

The harvest is there, everywhere, even I guess, in the most unlikely places: in our institutions, in our hospitals, homes, schools, prisons. It exists among all kinds of people: the sick, the old, the handicapped, prisoners, addicts, and the young.... How many are deeply wounded and in need of healing, encouragement and support. How many are without hope, without faith and without love..... And so the harvest is not reaped.

When Jesus looks at the world he sees that the harvest is indeed great, the opportunities many, the need pressing, and the time ripe. Jesus Christ calls to send every Christian into the world as a messenger of hope and love. The 'world' here means the area in which I live, my places of work, the people I meet everyday, and so on. Every day is a harvest day, and in every place there is a harvest to be reaped for Christ. An active concern for the world and for other people is an essential mark of a good Christian.

Sólo San Lucas nos informa sobre los Setenta y dos discípulos que Jesús envió. Al parecer, había demasiado que hacer para los Doce Apóstoles. Incluso después de haber elegido los setenta y dos, Jesús parece estar diciendo "no hay suficiente de ustedes". 'La cosecha es mucha y los trabajadores pocos; oren por más trabajadores para la cosecha.'

Este es una declaración optimista y sin embargo realista. <<< Que mucho bien hay que podría hacerse en el mundo >>> La cosecha es verdaderamente rica, para aquellos quienes tienen ojos para verlo. Pero, cuando las cosas están bajas, que pocos están dispuestos a ponerse a hacerlo. A menudo cedemos a la tentación de hacer excusas: 'No tengo tiempo, tengo tanto que hacer', etc., etc.

La cosecha está ahí, en todas partes, incluso creo que en los lugares más inesperados: en nuestras instituciones, en nuestros hospitales, hogares, escuelas, prisiones. Existe entre todo tipo de personas: los enfermos, los viejos, los incapacitados, prisioneros, adictos y los jóvenes... Cuántos están profundamente heridos y en necesidad de sanación, ánimo y apoyo. Cuántos están sin esperanza, fe y amor... y pues la cosecha no es cosechada.

5 Cuando Jesús mira el mundo ve que la cosecha es verdaderamente grande, las oportunidades muchas, la necesidad urgente y el tiempo maduro. Jesucristo llama a enviar a cada cristiano al mundo como un mensajero de esperanza y amor. El 'mundo' aquí significa el área en donde vivo, mi lugar de trabajo, la gente que conozco todos los días y así sucesivamente. Cada día es un día de cosecha, y en cada lugar hay una cosecha para ser cosechada para Cristo. Una preocupación activa para el mundo y para otras personas es una marca esencial de un buen cristiano.
