

Please keep in mind your safety and the safety of other parishioners

So, if you have some symptoms of illness, or you don't feel well or anyone in your family is sick, be cautious and do not come to the church. Stay home and pray the Mass online. Do not forget to pray for us, while we do the same for you.

Everyone who wants to enter the Church or attend these public Masses, is required to use a face cover during the whole Mass except for the reception of the Holy Communion.

Ushers are urged to use gloves as a safety measure to protect themselves and others they interact by virtue of their 'Greeting and Hospitality' ministry.

Stay 6 feet apart from others when possible. Avoid physical contact and do not shake hands, fist-bump, or hug.

As you enter the Church, one of the ushers will guide you or your whole family together to a designated pew depending on the number of your family members who can sit together without distancing.

All the churches are required to comply with social distancing protocols to place family groups together, while keeping them separate from other parishioners. Please do not change your pews. The Mass will be rather short, around half an hour, without singing.

The Holy Communion will be distributed during the Mass.

You are invited to receive the Holy communion in the palm of your hands, strictly following the direction given by the ushers who will let you go row by row, one pew after another, and column by column.

After receiving the Holy Communion, you are expected to return to your spot in the pews, till the Mass ends with the liturgical dismissal.

After the dismissal, we invite you to consider giving a helping hand to the ushers and the sanitizing team to wipe and sanitize the pews to make the Church ready and safe for the next Mass.
